## STATEMENT OF FACT

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Should this appropriation be approved, the funds will be administered by the Director of the Office of Energy Resources and used to supplement the State Energy Loan Fund (SELF). State Energy Loan Fund will and provide low-interest loans to residents commercial businesses for energy conservation projects. The funds would be used to make direct loans, to subsidize interest rates on approved loans, and to guarantee loans. This activity will be undertaken in cooperation with related programs offered by other state agencies, utilities and private lending institutions.

In November, 1982, the State of Maine received \$210,000 from the Sohio Oil Company as part of a federal settlement regarding alleged overcharges by Sohio. These funds were placed in the General Fund Undedicated Revenue Account. Therefore, the appropriation requested in this bill represents a transfer of funds which will not result in any General Fund revenue loss.

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
