- 1 mutilation, alteration or destruction of a work of 2 fine art.
- 3 <u>3.</u> Remedies. To effectuate the rights created 4 by this section, the artist or a member of the public 5 may commence an action to recover or obtain any of 6 the following:
- 7 <u>A. Injunctive relief;</u>
- 8 <u>B. Actual damages;</u>

9 C. Punitive damages. In the event that punitive 10 damages are awarded, the court shall, in its dis-11 cretion, select an organization or organizations 12 engaged in charitable or educational activities 13 involving the fine arts of this State to receive 14 such damages;

- 15D. Reasonable attorney's and expert witness16fees; and
- 17 E. Any other relief which the court deems 18 proper.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill provides artists with a right of action for injunctive relief or damages, or both, to protect and preserve works of art.
