11 Amend the Bill in the 4th, 5th, 6th and 7th lines  
12 after the amending clause (page 1, lines 27 to 30 in  
13 L.D.) by striking out all of the underlined words and  
14 punctuation and inserting in their place the follow-  
15 ing: 'except that no liquor may be sold or deliv-  
16 ered by any licensed Class A restaurant or qualified  
17 hotel between 1 a.m. and 11 a.m. on Sundays falling  
18 during the period from Easter Sunday to the Sunday  
before Labor Day'

STATEMENT OF FACT

21 The purpose of this amendment is to permit liquor  
22 sales by licensed Class A restaurants or hotels  
23 serving meals starting at 11 a.m. on Sundays that  
24 fall during the period from Easter Sunday until the  
Sunday before Labor Day.
