In cases of dispute, the state sealer shall check scale the disputed wood in such manner as he determines fair to all parties, as provided for in the appeal procedure of this section.
23	Butt scale may only be used until October 14, 1985.
25 26 27	This amendment stipulates that butt scale is allowed in transactions involving wood measurement until October 15, 1985.
