2	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
4	22 MRSA §1712 is enacted to read:
5	§1712. Itemized bills
6 7 8 9	Each hospital licensed by the State under chapter 405 shall inform all patients, or their legal guardians, in writing, at the time of the patient's discharge, that it will provide an itemized bill upon their request.

The request may be made by the patient or his legal guardian at discharge or at any time within 7 years after discharge.

The hospital shall provide an itemized bill to the person making the request within 30 days of the request.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This new draft modifies the bill, which had applied only to Medicare and Medicaid patients, by requiring that hospitals notify all patients in writing that they will provide itemized bills upon request. The request shall be made within 7 years of the patient's discharge, since hospitals do not keep these records indefinitely. The hospitals shall comply within 30 days of the request.
