11	clause (page 1, line 27 in L.D.) by inserting after
12	the striken out word "employee" the following: ', and
13	that violation is specifically determined to be a
14	serious violation,'
15	STATEMENT OF FACT
16	The purpose of this amendment is to make it clear
17	that the serious penalties of this section will not
18	come into force unless an employer willfully or
19	repeatedly commits serious violations of rules
20	promulgated by the Board of Occupational Safety and
21	Health. Under section 46 a serious violation exists
22	if there is a substantial probability that death or
23	serious physical harm could result from the viola-
24	tion.
