HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1097, L.D. 1445, Bill, "AN ACT to Allow Retailers to Sell Prison Made Items."
Amend the Bill in the last paragraph before the emergency clause in the last line (page 2, line 11 in L.D.) by inserting after the underlined word and punctuation "made." the following: 'The warden may not authorize any sale of articles produced at the prison, unless the manufacturer can show evidence of payment of state and federal income taxes and self- employment tax and show evidence that the net earn- ings of the manufacturer have been furnished to the Department of Human Services for use in determining eligibility for any form of aid or assistance.'
STATEMENT OF FACT
The purpose of this amendment is to require manu- facturers to meet certain requirements prior to authorization of the sale of articles produced at the Maine State Prison.
