## STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to require county commissioners to give orders to other county officers and employees only after the matter in question has been brought before the full board for discussion and decision. At present, there is nothing to prevent 3 different county commissioners from giving 3 sets of directions to the same county officer or employee which only produces confusion and resentment on the part of all parties.
