7 HOUSE AMENDMENT "/ " to S.P. 497, L.D. 1503, 8 Bill, "AN ACT to Clarify, Simplify and Improve Cer-9 tain Sections of the Labor Laws of Maine."

10 Amend the bill in section 8 in the 6th and 7th 11 lines (page 5, lines 32 and 33 in L.D.) by striking 12 out the following: "Maine Employment Security Unem-13 ployment Insurance Commission," and inserting in its 14 place the following: 'Maine Employment Security Com-15 mission,'

16 Further amend the bill in section 8 in the 9th 17 line (page 5, line 35 in L.D.) by inserting after the 18 word "statute" the underlined words '<u>or Executive</u> 19 Order'.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this amendment is to make L.D. 21 1503 consistent with L.D. 978. This amendment 22 authorizes the Commissioner of Labor to be paid from 23 24 administrative funds of the Bureau of Employment 25 Security, the Bureau of Labor Standards and other administrative funds which the commissioner 26 is 27 authorized by statute or Executive Order to adminis-28 ter. The Unemployment Insurance Commission is re-
