COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to

S.P. 496,

L.D. 1510, Bill, "AN ACT to Create the Maine Conservation Corps."

Amend the Bill by inserting before the enacting

11

clause the following:

12

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis-

13

lature do not become effective until 90 days after

14

adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

15

Whereas, in order for the program, as established

16

by the bill, to function effectively it is necessary

17

that it be commenced during the summer months when

18

the majority of work on public lands is carried out;

19

and

20

Whereas, unless this legislation is enacted as

21

emergency legislation it will not take effect before

22

the summer has ended; and

23

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature,

24

these facts create an emergency within the meaning of

25

the Constitution of Maine and require the following

26

legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-

27

vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,

28

therefore,'

Further amend the Bill in section 1 in that part

30

designated "§5151." in the first paragraph, 3rd line

31

(page 1, line 28 in L.D.) by striking out the under-

32

lined words "unemployed youth" and inserting in their

33

place the underlined words 'the unemployed'

34

Further amend the Bill in section 1 by striking

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out all of that part designated "§5152." and insert-

36

ing in its place the following:

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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 496, L.D. 1510

1 '§5152. Participants

2 Participants in the Maine Conservation Corps
3 shall be unemployed. No one may be eligible if he has
4 left employment or school for the purpose of parti-
5 cipating in this program.'

6 Further amend the Bill in section 1 in that part
7 designated "§5153." by striking out all of the 2nd
8 paragraph and inserting in its place the following:

9 'The director shall work with other agencies to
10 design the program to provide maximum work opportuni-
11 ties, job skills, training and improvements to pub-
12 licly-owned property.'

13 Further amend the Bill in section 1 in that part
14 designated "§5153." in the 3rd paragraph, 2nd line
15 (page 2, line 25 in L.D.) by inserting after the
16 underlined word and punctuation "Labor," the under-
17 lined word 'including'

18 Further amend the Bill in section 1 in that part
19 designated "§5153." by adding at the end the follow-
20 ing underlined paragraph:

21 'It is the legislative intent that any project
22 shall be of lasting and worthwhile significance to
23 the people of the State.'

24 Further amend the Bill by adding at the end
25 before the statement of fact the following:

26 'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency
27 cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect
28 when approved.'

29 STATEMENT OF FACT

30 The purpose of this amendment is to clarify the

1 legislative intent. The amendment adds an emergency
2 preamble and emergency clause to the bill.
