20 21 22 23 24	Further amend the bill in section 2 in that part designated "§1471-Q." in subsection 6 in the 5th line (page 3, line 21 in L.D.) by inserting after the underlined word "pesticide" the following: 'or at a place otherwise established by regulation'

26 27 28 29	This amendment takes into account situations where a dealer or distributor is also a farmer and it recognizes that dealers regularly deliver pesticides to the farmer on the farm.
