25 26 27 28 29 30 31 32 33 34 35	This amendment strikes the legislative findings and the establishment of dispensing fee rates for a 3rd-party prescription program. The amendment retains those portions of the original bill which require notification to the Bureau of Insurance and all pharmacies in the counties covered by the program; regulates denial of payment by the insurer to the pharmacy resulting from fraudulent or illegal use of an identification card; prohibits certain fixed charges imposed by the insurer; requires notification of contract renewal or changes; and the exception for
