21 22	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
23 24	29 MRSA §1368, 2nd ¶, as enacted by PL 1973, c. 58, is amended to read:
25 26 27 28 29 30 31 32 33 33	No vehicles, other than ambulances, fire depart- ment, police department and highway maintenance vehi- cles, shall may be equipped with a device which pro- vides for the alternate flashing of the vehicle's headlamps. Any motorcycle or motor driven cycle may be equipped with a means of modulating the upper beam of the headlamp between a high and a lower brightness at a rate of 200 to 280 flashes per minute. These headlamps shall not be modulated from 1/2 hour after sunset to 1/2 hour before sunrise.
