RESOLVE, Concerning Retirement Allowances
for Hester G. Brown and Ruth M. Hanna.

Hester G. Brown; retirement allowance. Resolved: That, notwithstanding any provision of the Revised Statutes, Title 5, Part 3, Hester G. Brown, of Hancock, wife of the late Chester E. Brown who was a former employee of the Department of Sea and Shore Fisheries, shall be paid a retirement allowance equal to 50% of the amount being paid to Chester E. Brown at the time of his death. These payments shall continue for the remainder of her lifetime or until she becomes the dependent of another person; and be it further

Ruth M. Hanna; retirement allowance. Resolved: That, notwithstanding any provision of the Revised Statutes, Title 5, Part 3, Ruth M. Hanna, of Hancock, wife of the late Austin E. Hanna who was a former employee of the State Highway Commission, shall be

1 paid a retirement allowance equal to 50% of the
2 amount being paid to Austin E. Hanna at the time of
3 his death. These payments shall continue for the
4 remainder of her lifetime or until she becomes the
5 dependent of another person.

6 STATEMENT OF FACT

7 The purpose of this resolve is to provide retire-
8 ment allowances for the widows of 2 former state
9 employees.
