Whereas, arson task forces bring together the many parties involved in arson response to share their ideas and find ways to prevent arson; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it

- Sec. 1. Department of Public Safety and Joint Standing Committee on Legal Affairs to study need for task force; report. Resolved: That the Department of Public Safety, Office of the State Fire Marshal, is authorized and directed to assist the Joint Standing Committee on Legal Affairs, which shall conduct a study to determine the need for a Statewide Task Force on Arson; and be it further
- Sec. 2. Committee, findings and recommendations. Resolved: That the committee shall report its findings and recommendations, together with any necessary implementing legislation, to the Second Regular Session of the 111th Legislature; and be it further
- Sec. 3. General Fund reimbursement on expenses for members of committee. Resolved: That the following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to reimburse members of the committee for reasonable travel and other expenses and to pay Legislators a per diem in order to carry out the purpose of this resolve. Any unexpended balance shall not lapse, but shall be carried forward until the purpose of this resolve has been accomplished.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this new draft is to authorize the Office of the State Fire Marshal to assist the Joint Standing Committee on Legal Affairs, which will conduct a study to determine the need for a Statewide Task Force on Arson. There is appropriated \$1,500 from the General Fund for committee expenses. The committee shall report to the Second Regular Session of the 111th Legislature.

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
