Bill, "AN ACT to Remove the Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages from Under the Department of Finance and Administration."

Amend the Bill in section 12 in subsection 5 in the last line (page 7, line 18 in L.D.) by inserting after the word "Act" the following: ', except as provided in subsection 6'

Further amend the Bill in section 12 by adding at the end the following:

'6. Special accounting and auditing services. The Department of Finance and Administration, through the Bureau of Accounts and Control, will continue to provide the Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages with special accounting services for the purchase of spirituous and vinous liquor, freight on those purchases and periodic inventory audits of warehouses and retail state liquor stores. The Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages will reimburse the General Fund each month for the cost of those services.'

'Sec. 13. Allocation of fund. In order to provide the necessary moneys for the 2 additional liquor commissioners, the following amounts are allocated from the revenues derived from operations of the Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages.
