A. Two hundred and eighty gain or receive the same state aid if Parts \(A\) and \(B\) are enacted;
B. Two hundred and eighty gain or receive the same state aid if Part \(A\) is enacted without Part B;
C. Two hundred and sixty-eight gain or receive the same state aid if Part \(B\) is enacted without Part A; and
D. Two hundred and eighty-two units gain if Part C is enacted.
3. The cost of grandfathering the few units which neither gain or receive the same would be \(\$ 3,389\), if both Parts \(A\) and \(B\) were enacted.
