13 14 15 16	Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 27 (page 11 lines 41 and 42, and page 12 lines 1 to 5 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:
17 18	'Sec. 27. 32 MRSA §9607, first ¶ , as amended by PL 1983, c. 204, §15, is further amended to read:
19 20 21 22 23	Every commercial driver education school shall be assessed for the actual expenses incurred by the board or its agents for <u>inspections</u> , special investi- gations or enforcement activities undertaken under this chapter.'
24 25	Further amend the bill by renumbering the sec- tions to read consecutively.
26 27	Further amend the bill by inserting before the Statement of Fact the following:
28	'FISCAL NOTE
29 30	Any fiscal impact of this bill will be Dedicated Revenue accounts.'
31	STATEMENT OF FACT
32	This amendment removes 2 provisions relating to

1 the State Board of Funeral Service. The effect of 2 those provisions would have been to require licensure 3 by the board of a number of people and organizations 4 currently not subject to board control. As written, it was perceived that the provisions would have reversed long-standing legislative policies concern-5 6 ing the regulatory power of funeral directors over providers of related services and individual author-7 8 9 ized persons.

10 This amendment also corrects section 27 to 11 reflect the passage of Public Law 1983, chapter 204.

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
