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7 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " H " to H.P. 1238, 8 L.D. 1647, Bill, "AN ACT to Encourage Competition in 9 Workers' Compensation Insurance Rates."

10 Amend the Bill in section 4 by striking out all 11 of subsection 3-B and inserting in its place the fol-12 lowing:

13 '3-B. Maximum premium rates. Rates determined 14 the superintendent under this section are maximum by 15 rates. Premium rates less than those approved may be used and filed with the superintendent. If the super-intendent has reason to believe that the filing pro-duces rates which are inadequate or unfairly discrim-16 17 18 19 inatory, he may disapprove them under Title 24-A, 20 chapters 23 and 25.

STATEMENT OF FACT

22 This amendment further clarifies the legislative 23 policy that insurers wishing to offer lower workers' compensation insurance rates than those established 24 through a rate filing may do so, without prior approval by the Superintendent of Insurance. As 25 26 amended, the insurer could make such downward devia-27 tions on a "use and file basis." The superintendent 28 29 could review the deviations already put into use to 30 assure that they are not inadequate or unfairly dis-31 criminatory, but otherwise he would not be involved 32 in the process.
