provided in this chapter or clearly indicated other-1 2 wise, the Maine Housing Authorities Act shall to the tribal housing authorities which hereinafter 3 may be referred to as "authority" or "authorities." 4 The power of such tribal housing authorities may be 5 6 exercised only within the Indian territory 7 respective tribe or nation, or the trust land of the Houlton Band of Maliseet Indians. Such tribal housing 8 9 authorities shall be in substitution for any tribal 10 housing authority heretofore existing under the laws of the State and shall assume all the rights 11 12 obligations of such predecessor housing authorities. The presently constituted tribal housing authority of 13 14 the respective tribe or nation shall continue in existence and shall exercise all the authority here-15 tofore vested by law in it until such time as 16 17 respective tribe or nation creates the tribal housing 18 authority authorized by this section.

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The purpose of this bill is to create a tribal housing authority for the Houlton Maliseet Indians.

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
