7 SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 1245, L.D. 1659,
8 Bill, "AN ACT to Ban Metal-piercing Ammunition."

9 Amend the Bill in that part designated "§1056."
10 by striking out all of the first line (page 1, line
11 23 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

12 '§1056. Trafficking in KTW ammunition'

13 Further amend the Bill in that part designated
14 "§1056." by striking out all of subsections 1 and 3
15 and inserting in their place the following:

16 '1. A person is guilty of trafficking in KTW
17 ammunition if he knowingly manufactures, imports,
18 sells, offers to sell, lends, gives away or purchases
19 that ammunition.

20 3. Trafficking in KTW ammunition is a Class D
21 crime.

22 STATEMENT OF FACT

23 This amendment removes the penalty for simple
24 possession but keeps the penalties for trafficking in
25 KTW ammunition.
