| 13 14 15 | Further amend the Bill in that part designated " <u>§1056.</u> " by striking out all of subsections 1 and 3 and inserting in their place the following: |
| 16 17 18 19 | '1. A person is guilty of trafficking in KTW ammunition if he knowingly manufactures, imports, sells, offers to sell, lends, gives away or purchases that ammunition. |
| 20 21 | <u>3. Trafficking in KTW ammunition is a Class D</u> crime.' |
| 22 | STATEMENT OF FACT |
| 23 24 25 | This amendment removes the penalty for simple possession but keeps the penalties for trafficking in KTW ammunition. |
