| This amendment would remove the phraseology which limits the definition of provider to physicians with a residency in psychiatry. Because the Board of Registration in Medicine does not license physicians in Maine by specialty, the reference is inappropriate. Its deletion will mandate reimbursement under the bill to all physicians, thus treating them the same as psychologists, social workers with a master's degree and psychiatric nurse practitioners. |
