1 Whereas, the lack of conformity with fedeal law 2 could ultimately result in the loss of federal funds 3 duly appropriated to the State; and

4 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, 5 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of 6 the Constitution of Maine and require the following 7 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-8 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now, 9 therefore,

10 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as 11 follows:

26 MRSA §1192, sub-§6-B is enacted to read:

13 6-B. Prohibition against disqualification of 14 individuals in approved training under United States Public Law 97-300. Notwithstanding any other provi-15 sions of this chapter, the acceptance of training for 16 such opportunities as are available through United 17 18 States Public Law 97-300 shall be deemed to be accep-19 tance of training with the approval of the State within the meaning of any other provisions of federal or state law relating to unemployment benefits. 20 21

22 **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency 23 cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect 24 when approved.
