Amend the bill in section 34 in paragraph L, in  
11 the 7th line (page 24, line 29 in L.D.) by striking  
12 out the underlined word "after" and inserting in its  
13 place the underlined word "in"

Further amend the bill in section 34 in paragraph  
15 L in the 8th line (page 24, line 30 in L.D.) by  
16 striking out the underlined words and punctuation "  
17 in his sole discretion,"

18

Further amend the bill in section 34 in paragraph  
19 L by adding at the end the following:

'If the recommendations of the hospital medical staff  
21 are not carried out, the warden shall immediately  
22 convey the reasons and circumstances for this deci-  
23 sion to the commissioner for his review and final  
24 disposition.'
