16 17 18 19 20 21 22 23	The unorganized territory shall pay 1/2 the costs of controlling and extinguishing forest fires in the unorganized territory until those costs reach 1/2 of 1% of its state valuation. This amount shall be collected through the Unorganized Territory Educational and Services Tax. All costs in excess of 1/2 of 1% of its state valuation shall be paid from the General Fund.
24 25 26 27 28	Further amend the bill in section 20, in subsection 2, 3rd, 4th and 5th lines (page 9, lines 22 to 24 in L.D.) by striking out the underlined punctuation and words ", including the amount charged to the fund under Title 12, section 9205-A"
29 30 31 32	Further amend the bill in section 21 in that part designated "§2714." in subsection 1 by striking out all of the last underlined sentence (page 12, lines 8 to 10 in L.D.)
33 34	Further amend the bill in the fiscal note by striking out the last line.

## SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 1342, L.D. 1781

This amendment repeals the 9¢ per acre charge to the unorganized territory for first response and makes the unorganized territory subject to the same 1/2 of 1% liability applicable to municipalities.
