21 22 23 24 25 26	The Review Committee on Tax Conformity shall conduct a general review of the issue of state-federal tax conformity and, by March 1, 1984, report its conclusions and recommendations to the Legislature. That report shall include legislation necessary to implement these recommendations.
27 28 29	The expenses of the public members of the review committee shall be paid from the Legislative Account.'

31 32 33 34 35	This amendment establishes a Review Committee on Tax Conformity to conduct a general review of the issue of state-federal tax conformity and make recommendations, in the form of legislation if necessary, to the Legislature by March 1, 1984.
