17 18 19	AN ACT to Ensure Timely Consideration of Requests for Rulemaking.
20 21	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
22 23	<b>35 MRSA §308</b> is amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:
24 25 26 27 28 29 30 31 32	In the event that the commission initiates rule- making proceedings pursuant to Title 5, section 8055, subsection 3, following receipt from any person of a petition for the adoption or modification of any rule, the commission shall, within 180 days of re- ceipt of the petition, conclude the rule-making pro- ceeding by entering an order adopting, rejecting or modifying the rule or modification sought by the pe- tition and stating the commission's reasons.

1	STATEMENT OF FACT
2	Under present law, the commission shall respond
3	to petitions for rulemaking within 60 days, either by
4	denying the petition or by initiating appropriate
5	rule-making proceedings. If the commission decides to
6	initiate rule-making proceedings, no time limits ap-
7	ply. This bill requires the Public Utilities Commis-
8	sion to complete within a reasonable time rule-making
9	proceedings initiated as a consequence of a petition
10	to the commission.
