A person serving as an industrial nurse or safety officer, a school or camp nurse, a life guard lifeguard, a ski patrolman, a nurse or technician in a hospital or a physician's office, or other similar occupation in which the person provides on-site emergency treatment at a single facility to the patrons or employees of that fa- cility; er

- 1 F. A person serving as a medical technician with 2 the United States Armed Forces, the Maine Army 3 National Guard or the Maine Air National Guard; ; 4 or

STATEMENT OF FACT

12 This bill makes clear that Maine nursing homes 13 may continue to transport their residents, in the 14 context of various group activities and trips to the doctor's office, without the necessity of utilizing a 15 licensed ambulance. The Maine Emergency Medical Ser-16 vices Act, as it is written, defines the term "ambu-lance" broadly to include "any vehicle" utilized in transporting "patients" unless a specific exemption 17 18 19 20 is provided.
