17 AN ACT Concerning Charges for Copies of  
18 Personal Hospital Records.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
21 follows:

22 22 MRSA §1711, last ¶, as enacted by PL 1977, c.  
23 122, is amended to read:

24 Reasonable costs incurred by the hospital in mak-  
25 ing and providing copies of medical records, not to  
26 exceed 10¢ for each page provided, shall be borne by  
27 the requesting person and the hospital may require  
28 payment prior to responding to the request.

1 STATEMENT OF FACT

2 The purpose of this bill is to provide that hos-  
3 pitals furnishing copies of medical records cannot  
4 charge more than 10¢ for each page of the records  
5 furnished.
