STATEMENT OF FACT

 The current law provides for emergency regulations but imposes a requirement for a public hearing, if requested prior to promulgation; a requirement inconsistent with the emergency nature of the proposed regulation in question, Revised Statutes, Title 12, section 6192. This bill clarifies that regulations promulgated under emergency conditions are effective immediately, while allowing for a public hearing, if requested, as soon as possible thereafter.

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
