15 16 This bill provides legislative authorization for the expenditure of funds for the 1984 Spruce Budworm Spray Project.

The Revised Statutes, Title 12, section 8426, requires the Legislature to determine this amount not later than February 15th. Once legislative authorization is provided, the budworm excise tax can be assessed and billed by the Bureau of Taxation.
