terpretation. There have been a number of very expensive renovation projects which local officials believed were major renovations and thus constituted a construction project. These misconceptions would have been avoided with more precise statutory language.

The original legislative intent was to permit the commissioner to determine whether it was more feasible to discontinue the usage of unsafe, unsuitable and obsolete buildings and replace them with complete new structures or to completely restore the existing structure to make it safe, suitable and appropriate to house today's modern educational program. The proposed new language makes clear this intent by replacing "major renovation" in current statutes with "complete restoration."
