20 21	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
22	20-A MRSA §6 is enacted to read:
23	§5. Military recruiters; duty to provide access
24	Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the
25	contrary, all public high schools and all institu-
26	tions within the state university system, and all
27	private high schools, colleges and universities which
28	receive state funds, shall offer the same on-campus
29	recruiting opportunities to representatives of state
30 31	or United States Armed Forces as they offer to
31	nonmilitary recruiters.

## STATEMENT OF FACT

2 This bill requires all public high schools, state 3 colleges and universities and all private schools, 4 colleges and universities to provide the same access 5 to their students to military recruiters as they pro-6 vide to nonmilitary recruiters.

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
