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AN ACT to Allow Coordination of
Services to Preschool Handicapped Children
Below the Age of 3 Years.
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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §7001, sub-§ 4, \|A, as enacted by PL 1981, c. 693, §§5 and 8, is repealed.

Sec. 2. 20-A MRSA §7703, sub-§5 is enacted to read:
5. Coordination services. Coordination and referral services may be provided to preschool handicapped children below the age of 3 years.

Maine has a very effective network of local sites providing and coordinating services to preschool handicapped children aged 3 to 5 years. These sites are continually being requested to provide referrals for children aged 0 to 3 years, but are prevented from doing so by a statutory age limit. This bill removes that limit but also assures that only coordination and referral services will be provided, thus eliminating any additional financial burden on the sites.

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
