18 Property in Little Squaw Township for Use as a

21 Conveyance of land to Town of Greenville. Re-  
22 solved: That the Director of Public Lands is autho-  
23 rized to convey to the Town of Greenville, for use as  
24 a sanitary facility, approximately 25 acres of land  
25 located on both sides of what is called the Dyer  
26 Road, 2 miles westerly of Route 15 in Greenville  
27 Junction.

29 The purpose of this resolve is to authorize the  
30 conveyance of state land in Little Squaw Township to  
31 the Town of Greenville to be used as a sanitary fa-
