Notwithstanding provisions of section 105-V, subsection 3, the term of office of the county commissioner from this district shall expire in 1984, in 1986 every 4 years thereafter.

- B. Commissioner District Number 2, in the County of Androscoggin, consists of the municipalities of Auburn, Durham, Mechanic Falls, Minot and Poland. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 105-V, subsection 3, the term of office of the county commissioner from this district shall expire in 1984, in 1986 and every 4 years thereafter.
- C. Commissioner District Number 3, in the County of Androscoggin, consists of that portion of the City of Lewiston north of a line described as follows: Beginning at the Androscoggin River at an inlet which approaches Lincoln Street; thence north along an inlet of the Androscoggin River, across Lincoln Street, to a point approaching Lisbon Street, east of Locust Street, the line to correspond to the boundary between House Dis-

tricts 67 and 69 and to the division lines be-tween Tracts 204 and 205, City of Lewiston, 1980 Federal Census of Maine; thence along a line to Lisbon Street; thence south on Lisbon Street to Arcadia Street; thence northeast on Arcadia Street to Pleasant Street; thence northwest on Pleasant Street to Bartlett Street; thence north on Bartlett Street to Walnut Street; thence east on Walnut Street to Webster Street; thence southeast on Webster Street to Mitchell Street; thence southwest on Mitchell Street to Pleasant Street; thence east on Pleasant Street to Lisbon Street; thence southeast on Lisbon Street (Rte. 196) across the Maine Turnpike to the Maine Central Railroad; thence east and south along the Maine Central Railroad tracks to the Lewiston-Lisbon boundary. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 105-V, subsection 3, the term of office of the county commissioner from this district shall expire in 1984 and every 4 years thereaf-ter.

2. Creation of Aroostook County Commissioner Districts. Aroostook County shall be divided into the following 3 districts.

- A. Commissioner District Number 1 consists of the municipalities of Amity, Ashland, Bancroft, Benedicta, Blaine, Bridgewater, Cary Plantation, Crystal, Dyer Brook, E Plantation, Easton, Fort Fairfield, Garfield Plantation, Glenwood Plantation, Hammond, Haynesville, Hersey, Hodgdon, Houlton, Island Falls, Linneus, Littleton, Ludlow, Macwahoc Plantation, Mars Hill, Masardis, Merrill, Monticello, Moro Plantation, Nashville Plantation, New Limerick, Oakfield, Orient, Oxbow Plantation, Reed Plantation, Sherman, Smyrna, Westfield, Weston, and the unorganized territories of central Aroostook and south Aroostook. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 105-V, subsection 3, the term of office of the county commissioner from this district shall expire in 1984 and every 4 years thereafter.
  - B. Commissioner District Number 2 consists of the municipalities of Allagash, Caribou, Castle

Hill, Chapman, Eagle Lake, Mapleton, Perham, Portage Lake, Presque Isle, St. Francis, St. John Plantation, Wade, Washburn, Westmanland, Winterville Plantation and the unorganized territories of northwest Aroostook and Square Lake. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 105-V, subsection 3, the term of office of the commissioner from this district shall expire in 1984, in 1986 and every 4 years thereafter.

- C. Commissioner District Number 3 consists of the municipalities of Caswell Plantation, Cyr Plantation, Fort Kent, Frenchville, Grand Isle, Hamlin, Limestone, Madawaska, New Canada, New Sweden, Saint Agatha, Stockholm, Van Buren, Wallagrass Plantation, Woodland and the unorganized territory of Conner. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 105-V, subsection 3, the term of office of the commissioner from this district shall expire in 1984, in 1986 and every 4 years thereafter.
- 3. Creation of Cumberland County Commissioner Districts. Cumberland County shall be divided into the following 3 districts.
  - A. Commissioner District Number 1 consists of the municipalities of Falmouth and Portland. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 105-V, subsection 3, the term of office of the commissioner from this district shall expire in 1984, in 1986 and every 4 years thereafter.
  - B. Commissioner District Number 2 consists of the municipalities of Baldwin, Cape Elizabeth, Gorham, Scarborough, South Portland, Standish and Westbrook. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 105-V, subsection 3, the term of office of the commissioner from this district shall expire in 1984, in 1986 and every 4 years thereafter.
  - C. Commissioner District Number 3 consists of the municipalities of Bridgton, Brunswick, Casco, Cumberland, Freeport, Gray, Harpswell, Harrison, Naples, New Gloucester, North Yarmouth, Pownal, Raymond, Sebago, Windham and Yarmouth. Notwith-

Commissioner District Number 3 consists of the municipalities of Avon, Carrabassett Valley, Carthage, Coplin Plantation, Dallas Plantation, Eustis, Kingfield, Madrid, New Vineyard, Phillips, Rangely Plantation, Rangely, Sandy River Plantation, Strong, Temple, Weld and the unorganized territorities of East Franklin, North Franklin, South Franklin, West Central Franklin and Wyman. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 105-V, subsection 3, the term of office of the commissioner from this district shall expire in 1986 and every 4 years thereafter.
- 5. Creation of Hancock County Commissioner Districts. Hancock County shall be divided into the following 3 districts.
  - A. Commissioner District Number 1 consists of the municipalities of Amherst, Aurora, Blue Hill, Dedham, Eastbrook, Ellsworth, Gouldsboro, Great Pond, Mariaville, Osborn, Otis, Sorrento, Sullivan, Surry, Waltham, Winter Harbor and the unorganized territorities of Central Hancock,

East Hancock and North Hancock. Notwithstanding
the provisions of section 105-V, subsection 3,
the term of office of the commissioner from this
district shall expire in 1984, in 1986 and every
years thereafter.

- B. Commissioner District Number 2 consists of the municipalities of Brooklin, Brooksville, Bucksport, Castine, Deer Isle, Orland, Penobscot, Sedgwick, Stonington and Verona. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 105-V, subsection 3, the term of office of the commissioner from this district shall expire in 1984 and every 4 years thereafter.
- C. Commissioner District Number 3 consists of the municipalities of Bar Harbor, Cranberry Isles, Franklin, Frenchboro, Hancock, Lamoine, Mount Desert, Southwest Harbor, Swan's Island, Tremont and Trenton. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 105-V, subsection 3, the term of office of the commissioner from this district shall expire in 1984, in 1986 and every 4 years thereafter.
- 6. Creation of Kennebec County Commissioner Districts. Kennebec County shall be divided into the following 3 districts.
  - A. Commissioner District Number 1 consists of the municipalities of Augusta, Chelsea, China, Randolph, Sidney, Vassalboro and Windsor. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 105-V, subsection 3, the term of office of the commissioner from this district shall expire in 1984, in 1986 and every 4 years thereafter.
  - B. Commissioner District Number 2 consists of the municipalities of Belgrade, Farmingdale, Fayette, Gardiner, Hallowell, Litchfield, Manchester, Monmouth, Mount Vernon, Pittston, Readfield, Rome, Vienna, Wayne, West Gardiner and Winthrop. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 105-V, subsection 3, the term of office of the commissioner from this district shall expire in 1984 and every 4 years thereafter.

- C. Commissioner District Number 3 consists of the municipalities of Albion, Benton, Clinton, Oakland, Waterville, Winslow, and Unity Township.

  Notwithstanding the provisions of section 105-V, subsection 3, the term of office of the commissioner from this district shall expire in 1984, in 1986 and every 4 years thereafter.

- C. Commissioner District Number 3 consists of the municipalities of Appleton, Camden, Hope, Rockport, Union and Washington. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 105-V, subsection 3, the term of office of the commissioner from this district shall expire in 1984 and every 4 years thereafter.

Notwithstanding the provisions of section 105-V, subsection 3, the term of office of the commissioner from this district shall expire in 1984 and every 4 years thereafter.
- 9. Creation of Oxford County Commissioner Districts. Oxford County shall be divided into the following 3 districts.
  - A. Commissioner District Number 1 consists of the municipalities of Andover, Bethel, Brownfield, Denmark, Fryeburg, Gilead, Hanover, Hiram, Lovell, Newry, Norway, Porter, Stoneham, Stow, Sweden, Waterford and the unorganized territories of North Oxford and those portions of South Oxford known as Batchelders Grant and Mason. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 105-V, subsection 3, the term of office of the commissioner from this district shall expire in 1984, in 1986 and every 4 years thereafter.
  - B. Commissioner District Number 2 consists of the municipalities of Byron, Dixfield, Lincoln Plantation, Magalloway Plantation, Mexico, Peru, Roxbury, Rumford and Upton. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 105-V, subsection 3, the term of office of the commissioner from this district shall expire in 1984, in 1986 and every 4 years thereafter.

- C. Commissioner District Number 3 consists of the municipalities of Buckfield, Canton, Greenwood, Hartford, Hebron, Otisfield, Oxford, Paris, Sumner, West Paris, Woodstock and the un-organized territories of Milton and that portion of South Oxford known as Albany.
