HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 709, L.D. 1955, Bill, "AN ACT to Amend Certain Rules of the Emergency Medical Services."

Amend the amendment by inserting at the end before the statement of fact a new paragraph to read:

'In addition, notwithstanding current regulations, the following conditions shall apply. Reguirements for licensure at the intermediate level shall allow an applicant to be licensed for intravenous therapy or defibrillation therapy, or both. If a licensed ambulance service operating within this State is sold to a new operator, the ambulances licensed to that service on the date of sale shall be licensed and relicensed by the new operator, as long as they are maintained in a condition which will meet all Department of Public Safety standards for vehicle safety and are in a clean and sanitary condition, free from interior rust, dirt or contaminating foreign matter.'
