27 28 29	As used in this chapter, unless the context indi- cates otherwise, the following terms have the follow- ing meanings.
30 31 32 33	1. Commercial establishment. "Commercial estab- lishment" means any building open to the public which is used primarily for the wholesale or retail sale of goods or services or manufacture of products.

1 §1622 Notice of microwave in use; display

2 <u>Any commercial establishment operating a micro-</u> 3 wave oven on the premises shall conspicuously and 4 prominently post and display a notice which states 5 that a microwave oven is in use.

6 §1623 Rules

7 The department may promulgate rules necessary to 8 implement this chapter.

10 <u>Failure to display a notice, as required in sec-</u> 11 <u>tion 1622, shall be a civil violation for which a</u> 12 forfeiture not to exceed \$100 may be adjudged.
