## STATEMENT OF FACT

 The purpose of this resolve is to authorize the Town of Bingham to improve the drainage of Meadow Brook in Bingham. Currently, the brook is not flowing along the original brook bed but is flowing over flat land and fields. This results in a great deal of flooding and water damage to the 138 houses in the vicinity.

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
