21 22	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

The com- mittees elected at the convention shall organize within 30 days after the convention by electing such officers as prescribed in their bylaws. The secretary of each committee shall advise the state committee <u>of</u> the name and residence of its chairman and secretary within 10 days after its organization their election. 3. Term of office and duties of committees. The
33 34	committees and their officers shall hold office until the next state convention unless otherwise as pre-

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scribed in their bylaws, and shall perform the duties imposed upon them by the convention at which they were chosen and their bylaws.

STATEMENT OF FACT

5 The purpose of this bill is to allow state polit-6 ical party committees to determine when their offi-7 cers shall be elected. This bill removes the re-8 quirement that these officers be elected within 30 9 days of the party's convention.

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
