1-A and inserting in its place the following:

'1-A. Violation. A violation of section 7371,
subsection 3, is a Class E crime, provided that the
convicted person shall be subject to a minimum fine
of not less than \$50 plus an amount equal to twice
the applicable license fee, this fee fine not to be
suspended.'

The purpose of this amendment is to establish a
minimum fine for hunting without a license. Under
this amendment, the nonsuspendable minimum fine is
\$50, plus an amount equal to twice the applicable li-
cense fee.
