18 Hunting without a License.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 12 MRSA §7901, sub-§1-A, as enacted by PL 1983,
23 c. 588, §14, is amended to read:

24 1-A. Violation. A violation of section 7371,
25 subsection 3, is a Class E crime, provided that, in
26 addition to any fine imposed, the convicted person
27 shall be subject to a ~~fine~~ penalty of not less than
28 twice the applicable license fee, this fee not to be
29 suspended.

30 STATEMENT OF FACT

31 The purpose of this bill is to clarify the law
32 concerning hunting without a license. The bill pro-

1 vides that in addition to the fine imposed, the con-
2 victed person must pay a penalty equal to twice the
3 license fee he would have paid if he had obtained a
4 license.
