1	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature,
2	these facts create an emergency within the meaning of
3	the Constitution of Maine and require the following

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

28 MRSA §153, as amended by PL 1981, c. 555, is further amended by adding after the first paragraph a new paragraph to read:

Notwithstanding this section, the State Liquor Commission may establish on a seasonal basis additional agency stores to be located within the municipalities of Kennebunk, Kennebunkport, Old Orchard Beach and York. These seasonal licenses shall not commence prior to May 25th and shall not be issued for more than 4 months' duration.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Kennebunk, Kennebunkport, Old Orchard Beach and York are heavy tourist areas where our present state liquor stores cannot provide effective service during the summer months. These locations cater heavily to foot traffic and would alleviate vehicular traffic, an energy savings measure.
