18 19 20 21 22 23	Many other Maine statutes protect the rights of Christian Scientists who rely solely on their reli- gious practice for the prevention and cure of dis- ease. The Revised Statutes, Title 22, section 1532 of this legislative document contains a similar pro- vision.
24 25 26	Without this provision, the bill could intrude on constitutional rights of freedom of religion and parents' rights.
