15 16 17 18 19 20 21 22 23	Under this amendment, a holder of a Maine farm winery license could only sell wines containing 14.5% or less alcohol without the option to fortify the wines with a greater alcohol content. The option is unnecessary because the fruit wines produced in Maine normally contain less than 14.5% alcoholic content. This change conforms with federal law, and also ensures that wines of a higher alcohol content will contine to be sold only in state liquor stores.
