Whereas, certain previously unanticipated revenues are expected to be made available to the State by the Federal Government as a result of an increase in the grant award from the United States Department of Energy for the Program of Weatherization Assistance for Low-income Persons, and those revenues must be expended by March 31, 1984; and
