- 1. Line-item budget. All funds of the department shall be allocated by the Legislature, in the same manner as are appropriations from the General Fund, in a gross unified budget and shall be subject to the transfer provisions of Title 5, section 1585.
  - 2. Unencumbered balances. Any unencumbered allocated balances, including existing balances, shall be carried forward into the next fiscal year and shall not be expended without allocation by the Legislature.
- 3. Revenues. Actual revenues received in excess of that estimated and allocated by the Legislature shall not be expended without allocation by the Legislature.
- 19 4. Cash reserve. The department shall maintain 20 as practical a cash reserve for the purpose of ensuring an adequate cash flow.
- 5. Bond issue. The department shall submit to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over inland fisheries and wildlife plans for a bond issue prior to submission of the bond issue to the full Legislature.

- 9. <u>Unneeded property.</u> The Governor, on recommendation of the commissioner, may sell and convey on 1 2 3 behalf of the State the interests of the State in property taken or acquired by purchase under chapters 4 5 701 to 721 and deemed no longer necessary for the 6 purposes of those chapters. The commissioner, with the approval of the Governor, may lease these same 7 properties. The proceeds from these sales or leases 8 9 shall be credited to the funds of the department.

## 28 STATEMENT OF FACT

- Section 1 increases legislative control of the budget of the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife.
- 32 Section 2 provides that the General Fund shall 33 reimburse in full the Department of Inland Fisheries 34 and Wildlife for expenses incurred in search and res-35 cue efforts.
- Section 3 allows the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to lease, as well as sell, unneeded property.
