1984, the Androscoggin Lake Improvement Corporation requests ownership of the dam, in which case, the Commissioner of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources is authorized and directed to convey to the Androscoggin Lake Improvement Corporation or the Town of Wayne or Leeds by quitclaim deed, for \$1 and other good and valuable consideration, all right, title and interest of the State in and to the dam, including the appurtenant works, the site on which it is located and appurtenant rights of flowage and access.

Conveyance of the dam is conditioned on an agreement that if the Androscoggin Lake Improvement Corporation, its successors or assigns, shall later sell the dam, its appurtenant works or the land on which it is located, the proceeds of that sale shall be paid to the General Fund of the office of the Treasurer of State. The commissioner may also include in the conveyance such other covenants as he deems advisable to protect the State, its officers and employees from any liability which may arise from its past ownership of the dam.

Subject to survey and title search, the site on which the dam is located is bounded and described as set forth in Volumn 119, Pg.421, of the Androscoggin County Registry of Deeds.

26 STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill provides for the abandonment of the state-owned dam on the Androscoggin River in Leeds and for the Department of Environmental Protection to institute proceedings under the Revised Statutes, Title 38 to dispose of the dam, unless, on or before October 1, 1984, the Androscoggin Lake Improvement Corporation requests conveyance, in which case, the Commissioner of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources shall convey ownership to the corporation.
