19 20 21 22 23 24	RESOLVE, Authorizing the Commissioner of Mental Health and Mental Retardation to Enter into Agreements to Supply Water to Neighbors of Pineland Center Whose Wells are Contaminated.
25 • 26 27 28	Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
29 30 31	Whereas, the water in wells of certain property owners surrounding the Pineland Center has become contaminated; and
32 33	Whereas, this creates a serious health hazard which should be remedied as soon as possible; and

1 Whereas, this legislation must be enacted as 2 emergency legislation to permit the Commissioner of 3 Mental Health and Mental Retardation to enter into 4 agreements with those property owners to supply them 5 with water; and

6 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, 7 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of 8 the Constitution of Maine and require the following 9 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-10 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now, 11. therefore, be it

12 Commissioner of Mental Health and Mental Retarda-13 tion; authorization. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Mental Health and Mental Retardation may enter 14 15 into agreements with persons owning or occupying 16 property surrounding Pineland Center whose well water 17 is contaminated to supply those persons with water.

18 Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited 19 in the preamble, this resolve shall take effect when 20 approved.

STATEMENT OF FACT

22 The purpose of this resolve is to authorize the Commissioner of Mental Health and Mental Retardation 23 to enter into agreements with persons occupying prop-24 25 erty around Pineland Center for the supplying of water to those whose well water is contaminated. 26
